The Murrysville Community Library is pleased to announce that we are offering new hours starting on Monday, September 28<sup>th</sup>. The Library will be open Mondays from 10am to 7pm, Tuesdays 10am to 5pm, Wednesdays 10am to 7pm, Thursdays 10am to 5pm, Fridays 10am to 5pm, and Saturdays 10am to 4pm.

In person appointments will no longer be necessary. Please feel free to visit us anytime the Library is open. However, out of an abundance of caution, we are observing a building capacity limit and ask that you keep your library usage time to an hour or less to ensure that everyone may enjoy the Library.

Love our curbside pickups? Curbside pickups for holds will still be available for those that enjoy it. Please contact the Library at 724-327-1102 to schedule your curbside pickup during our new operating hours. Automatic hold notifications from the Westmoreland Library Network will resume. If you would like to place a hold on your next great read, please visit your online account through the catalog or call us!

Please continue to return items into our Book Drop, located outside by the front entrance. All items are being quarantined for 72 hours before they are checked back in and returned to circulation. If you are returning a Wonderbook or Launchpad, please call the Library and schedule a drop off.

The Library will continue to offer our usual patron services, like reader's advisory, patron printing and copying services. Computer time limits for patrons have been expanded to an hour. Because of social distancing, only limited computer assistance can be offered. Public headphones will not be available. If you need sound, please bring your own headphones/earbuds. If you do not have your own, the Library has a supply of disposable earbuds for purchase. The price is \$2.00 and are yours to keep.

The health of our patrons and staff is of the utmost importance to us. With that in mind, all individuals entering the Library and throughout their entire visit must wear a face covering that covers the individual's mouth and nose unless they have a medical condition that impedes their ability to wear a face covering. Children two years of age and under are not required to wear a face covering. For those that cannot wear a face covering due to a medical condition, we will offer the following accommodations: use of a Library provided face shield or a curbside appointment.
